A season for new trees

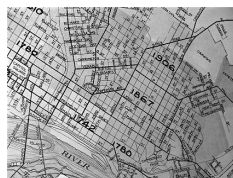
The adopt-a-tree trees are starting to pop up all over the place. Help to water our new trees and keep'em alive!

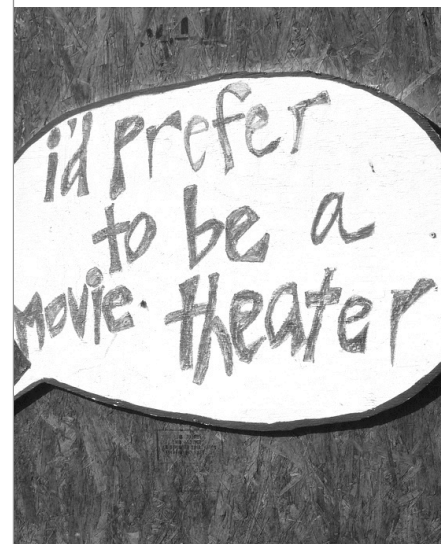
