Significant Arrest

Weapons Seizure, B2300 Ambrose: While the FMT Anti Crime Unit was investigating people for trespassing on RRHA property. Sgt Greene and Detective Taylor approached an individual, who as they approached ran to a door screaming and began acting in a very nervous manner, (shaking). The individual was apprehended and found in his possession was a 38 caliber amadio revolver and marijuana.

Weapons Seizure, B2300 Ambrose: While the FMT Anti Crime Unit was investigating people for trespassing on RRHA property, Detectives Moore and Taylor approached an individual, who as they approached ran. During the foot pursuit the individual removed a .380 cal Jimenez Arms semi automatic pistol from his right coat pocket and threw it in a trash can. The weapon was retrieve and the individual apprehended. The subject was charged with Possession of firearm by a felon, Concealed Weapon, and Trespassing.

Officers Waite and Huddleston partnered with the new Property manager of Whitcomb Housing Community and cited 10 abandoned vehicles and arrested an individual, after receiving information that the individual indictments issued from the Special Investigations Division.

VEHICLE PURSUIT: At the 2900 block of Kane St., Officers Bryson and Parker observed a red Dodge Neon that was possibly used in an armed robbery earlier in the evening and it was stolen out of Prince George County. Five suspects were in the vehicle. The Officers initiated a traffic stop in the 2900 block of Kane St and the suspects did not stop. The pursuit continued to the intersection of

22nd St. and Fairfield Ave. where the suspect wrecked into a parked car. All five suspects fled the vehicle and 4 were apprehended. There were no injuries. A Smith & Wesson .357 handgun was recovered from the vehicle. Detective Howell responded and interviewed the suspects in reference to the earlier robbery. All 4 suspects were charged with Robbery, Use of a firearm, Possession of Stole Property and the driver with felony Eluding.

Crime Prevention Tips
