Significant Arrest

Robbery- Individual, B2400 Whitcomb- The victim, stated that he was getting on the bus when he was grabbed from behind, spun around and struck in the head by the suspect. The suspect then pointed a silver handgun at the victim and stated, "if you don't have any money I'll kill you". The suspect searched the victim's pockets, taking the victim's cell phone, touch and other items. The victim then went to Church's Chicken and reported the incident. The victim stated that he knew the suspect from school but could not remember his name. The suspect, a 17 year old black male, was later identified and arrested by FMT Officers.

Robbery- Individual, B1600 Rogers Street- The Victim was walking to the Stop and Go Mart, at Mechanicsville Tnpk and Fairfield Ave. The suspects passed the victim going in the opposite direction. Once they passed the victim, the suspects then turned around and followed the victim to the intersection of Roger St and Fairfield Ave. They asked the victim to buy them a beer, but the victim refused. Suspect #1 pulled out a small black revolver and placed it to the victims head, cocking the hammer. Suspect #1 then said “give me all your money”. The victim handed over \$22.00, a grey pocket knife, lottery tickets and his wallet. Suspect #2 searched the victim’s pockets. Suspect #1 told the victim to take them to his house and grabbed the victim’s arms. The victim refused, broke free and started running away. A neighbor was watching and called the police. After brief foot pursuits the suspects, both 17 years old, were apprehended and arrested. K9 Officer Agee and his partner responded to the scene, conducted a search and located the firearm under 6 inches of snow.

*** The mother of Suspect #1 responded to the scene and became disorderly trying to get to her son numerous times. She was ordered to leave several times and was eventually arrested for Obstruction and Possession of Heroin.

Narcotics Detectives conducted a multi gram crack buy/walk operation from a known target in Henrico County that supplies several areas in Sector 113. The party is targeted for federal prosecution.

Search Warrants

SEARCH WARRANT, 1911 Whitcomb Street, - FMT officers conducted a Knock and Talk and observed a small amount of marijuana. Officer Taylor then obtained a search warrant for the residence. A digital scale and 16 grams of marijuana was recovered from the residence.

Crime Prevention Tips

1. ***Auto Thefts- Don’t leave vehicles running unattended.***
2. ***Burglaries- When possible, vary the times when leaving and returning home, timers on lights are good deterrents. Ensure door and window locks work. Let police know when you will be away for an extended period of time. Notify police of strangers lurking in your neighborhood or any suspicious persons, vehicles or activity.***
3. ***Robberies- Walk in well lighted areas. Be aware of your surroundings. Don’t carry large amounts of money on your person.***

Report suspicious persons in your neighborhoods. When walking during late hours, try not to do so alone.
