# 2014 Poverty Thresholds

- Poverty threshold for a 4-person family: \$24,230
- Poverty threshold for one person:
  - ▶ Under age 65: \$12,316
  - ▶ 65 years and over: \$11,354

## Percent of Population Living in Poverty






### Poverty Growth/Decline: 2000-2014

















# Poverty in Richmond


### PERCENT BY RACE OF POOR IN RICHMOND


### PERCENT BY RACE OF POOR IN HENRICO






### PERCENT BY RACE OF POOR IN CHESTERFIELD


